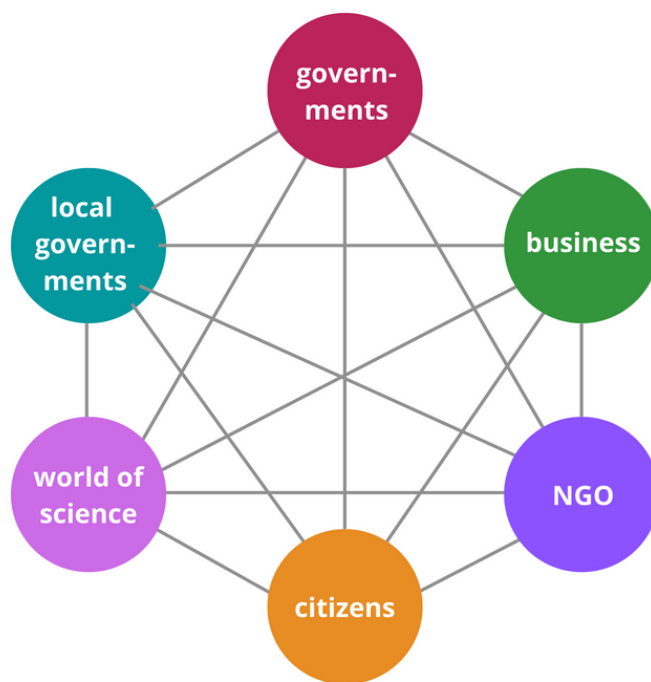
### AIM FOR TOMORROW. TODAY!
